PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS & INVESTMENT OPPORTUNITIES



14 km Greenfield High-Standard Roadway
New modern international standard corridor designed for future growth and connectivity.



Dual Carriageway (4-Lane) Section
First 3.8 km will be a 4-lane dual carriageway to accommodate future traffic and urban expansion.



5 Major Bridges
Includes iconic Mau River Bridge (~1005m) and 4 other bridges with spans ranging from 320m to 800m.



Wildlife / Elephant Corridor
Dedicated wildlife (elephant) corridor (~250m) integrated into bridge design for biodiversity conservation.



World Bank Environmental & Social Framework (ESF)
Developed under the World Bank's Environmental and Social Framework ensuring sustainability, safety and climate-resilient design.



Tentative Project Cost: USD 180–190 Million
A significant infrastructure investment opportunity in Bhutan's growth and connectivity corridor.



3 Civil Work Contracts
Packaging strategy includes a minimum of 3 separate civil work contracts for road and bridges.



Detailed Design Completion by October 2026
Final packaging will be decided once the detailed design is completed.
