Introduction

The Construction Industry Development Council was set up in 1996 by the Planning Commission, Government of India along with Construction Industry, to shape up the Indian Construction Industry. Shri Chander Verma, Managing Director, Continental Constructions Ltd. is Chairman of CIDC. CIDC has amongst its 89 members from various Ministries, Government Departments, PSUs, Construction Companies, Financial Institutions, Educational and R&D Institutions. During this period CIDC has taken up several important projects related to the issues, vital to the Construction Industry including:

1. *Standardizing the Contract Conditions for Domestic Bidding.*
2. *Computation and publication of Construction Cost Indices*
3. *Human Resource Development*
 - *Training of Workers, Supervisors & Managers.*
 - *Diploma Programme in Civil, Electrical and Mechanical Engineering – for Army Jawans*
 - *Vocational & Job oriented training for the secondary level students.*
 - *CIDC has active agreements with eight State Government for the purpose of development of human resources in their respective state.*
4. *Setting up the first Arbitration & Dispute Resolution Centre for Construction Contracts.*
5. *Development and application of systems for Construction Financing, Banking and Taxation.*
6. *Development & Implementation of Grading System.*
7. *Networking with National and International construction bodies.*
8. *Establishing a Construction Equipment Bank.*
9. *Development of Insurance cover/ Investments for construction sector Projects.*
10. *Development of RBI approved Harmonized Eligibility Criteria for Lending to Construction Entities*
11. *JNNURM, Ministry of Urban Development, GOI, has constituted a Working Group, with Director General, CIDC as the Chairman to evolve the tendering & procurement practices for implementation.*

CIDC has been corresponding with the Senior Officials of several Ministries, PSUs and Project authorities at Central and State level and organising personalized meetings & seminar.

The Working Group on “Construction in the Eleventh Five-Year Plan (2007-2012)” has now been constituted by the Planning Commission. Dr. Anwarul Hoda, Member, Planning Commission is the Chairman and Shri P. R. Swarup, DG, CIDC is Convenor of the Working Group.

EXECUTIVE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:
