

CIDC conducts First Task Force Meeting for the CIDC - Construction Industry Database



On the 25th of July 2014, The Construction Industry Development Council (CIDC) conducted the first task-force meeting for instilling the CIDC - Construction Industry Database.

This meeting was attended by various stakeholders of CIDC featuring leading industry experts from RIETS, L&T, EIL, CPWD, NBCC, IRCON, CE&CR, Urban News Digest, Times Business Solutions Ltd. etc. The primary agenda of this meeting was to discuss and enhance the various categories of classification present under the database and Constitution of the Jury that would participate in the verification and authentication process of interested vendors. This meeting was Chaired by Dr. P.S Rana, Chairman CIDC and conducted by Dr. P.R Swarup, Director General CIDC.

The enlistments done by various project authorities and the databases available in the market

are of varying vintage. This often leads to the vendor's details not getting updated, resulting in old & non-existent vendor data.

During the course of the meeting, CIDC's previous experience of compiling such databases for ONGC, JNNURM and other assignments was highlighted and based on the same, it was decided to build one single national database where all other databases may merge, creating one seamless database comprising of construction companies, material handling organizations and service providers for use by all stakeholders under the public domain.



Suggestions were sought from all members on how to expand the database to make it all inclusive & ways to improve the categorization and make it more meaningful
